



Message: 'UNITING 4570 - GIFT & WILL

with Rev David Fanning

Scriptures: Ephesians 2:11-22 and 4:1-6 (Good News Translation)

Forty-seven years ago on the 22nd June 1977, The Congregational Union of Australia, the Methodist Church of Australasia and the Presbyterian Church of Australia, in fellowship with the whole Church Catholic, and seeking to bear witness to that unity which is both Christ's gift and his will for the Church, hereby enter into union under the name of the Uniting Church in Australia. (Basis of Union Paragraph 1)

(This union came about after each denomination had voted in favour according to necessary majorities being obtained in 1972.)

The only reason for this union was a seeking to bear witness to that unity which is both Christ's gift and his will for the Church.



In his letter to the Christians in Ephesus,
Paul talks about this unity as gift and will.
Many of the Christians there had been Gentiles
(non-Jews) prior to their conversion. Likewise, the
Jewish Christians in the congregation had been
Jews. (Stop and read Ephesians 2:11-22. Note the
number of times Paul mentions Christ as the one
who has brought them together.)
For Christ himself has brought us peace by making

Jews and Gentiles one people (Ep 2:14)

It is through Christ that all of us, Jews and Gentiles, are able to come in the one Spirit into the presence of the Father. (2:18)

Unity is Christ's Gift. The Uniting Church sought to bear witness to that Gift.

In Ephesians 4: we meet unity as Christ's will. (Take the time to read Eph. 4:1-6). Do your best to preserve the unity which the Spirit gives by means of the peace that binds us together (4:3).

Unity is Christ's Will. The Uniting Church sought to bear witness to that Will.

Uniting 4570 is a most challenging name. The word 'Uniting' links the congregation to those who had the vision in 1977 to bear witness to that gift and unity. It is essential Uniting Church DNA. And that DNA has its roots in the life and ministry of Jesus, the foundation (2:20) on which the church is built. Uniting 4570 is a visionary name, an affirmation of who you are in Christ and who you want to be in your relationships with one another and the community.

Your name provides an excellent framework for your mission into the 4570

communities. Celebrate the gift of unity that is yours in Christ. And do all you can to maintain that unity in your daily lives and witness.

By the way, our Lord started praying for you (and continues to pray for you) a long time ago. And that prayer is John 17:20-26.

And, remember the dance again. Rejoice in your union with the Lord. Show a gentle (generous) attitude to everyone. (Philippians 4:4,5)

THE COVERING OF LOVE

Our current culture is not grounded in a social structure of forgiveness. It seems as though the Biblical truth of mankind's sin and its remedy of forgiveness by the Creator is not on many people's radar. For example, if someone in the political arena is discovered to have said something offensive recently or in years past, they are pounced upon and condemned as a bad person. The "cancel culture" stands ready with a cry of "off with their heads!" Slips of the tongue, unintended snubs, as well as truly inappropriate comments are all thrown together into the bubbling cauldron of offenses. Even if the guilty party apologizes, it's not enough.

Why is there such a loud outcry for punishment? Perhaps the answer lies in a lack of awareness of grace.

If the majority of a people don't believe they are sinners yet they see sin in others, someone must be punished and it 'isn't going to be them'. There is also a lack of awareness of redemption. There is an assumption that the offender will always behave in the same way. This cynical world view arises from a lack of experience of forgiveness and grace.

The gospel of the world seems to be ...

"Not all have sinned and fallen short, (some of us are perfect, it's always the other guy) ... and there is no glory of God. We have to be perfect because there is no cover for sin. We must have a scapegoat so that the sin of the evildoers is gone."


On the other hand, the Gospel is ...

"All have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. God's love covers a multitude of sins. Sin is wiped away by the blood of Jesus."

Ahh! what a breath of fresh air to hear that:

"Love keeps no record of wrongs." 1 Corinthians 13:5.

"Blessed are those whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered." Romans 4:7.
