## Message: 'Encounter the Storms - Dance In The Rain'

with Rev David Fanning

Scriptures: Mark 4:35-41 and Philippians 4:4-8 (Good News Translation)

## "Life is not about waiting for the storms to pass, it's about learning to dance in the rain".

Storms come in all shapes and sizes. There are personal storms, storms which threaten the cohesiveness of community and a nation. International storms are not only brewing, but are breaking out on most continents around the world.

Storms do not discriminate.

They attack everyone no matter who they are. People of faith or no faith are not



exempt. And of course that means all Christians as well. Storms, in this life, never cease. There will always be the next storm.

Paul, in his letter to the Philippians, teaches us how to dance in the rain. There are four steps to the dance:

- Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice. In the Good News Bible, the meaning is expressed well - "May you always be joyful in your union with the Lord." (Phil 4:4) Not rejoicing in the storms, but in your relationship with the Lord being in Christ.
- 2. "Show a gentle attitude towards everyone." (4.5a) In The Message, Eugene Petersen puts it this way - "Make it as clear as you can to all you meet that you're on their side, working with them and not against them". Be generous towards others.
- 3. The Lord is near Never forget the nearness of the Lord. (4.5b)
- 4. Don't worry over anything whatever, tell God every detail of your needs in earnest and thankful prayer (4:6) (J.B Phillips). We ask in a spirit of thanksgiving.

And the outcome of the dance - The peace of God will guard your hearts and minds in (your union) with Christ. (4:7). It does not mean the storms will disappear.

P.S. My thinking on this topic has been greatly influenced by Max Lucado's book, "Anxious for Nothing - Finding Calm in a Chaotic World".


